## **Cleaning and maintaining veneered and lacquered surfaces.**

**Note on COVID-19:** Despite the COVID pandemic, the Robert-Koch Institute (RKI) does not recommend the routine disinfection of surfaces in domestic and public areas, including that of frequent contact surfaces. Appropriate cleaning is the preferred approach.

**General information:** Veneered and lacquered surfaces do not require any intensive cleaning. The UV-hardened acrylic resin lacquered coats (water-based UV lacquer) ensure easy maintenance. It is advisable to be careful, in particular in the case of hard, rough, pointed or sharp-edged objects such as, for example, protective studs or buckles on briefcases. Solvent-based substances (e.g. including nail varnish) can also damage the lacquer.

**Standard maintenance:** Regularly dry-wipe table surfaces and, in addition, also occasionally wipe with a soft, damp cloth (use household detergent sparingly). Then rub over with a dry cloth.

If possible, wipe away spilt liquids (water, coffee, tea etc.) with a soft dry or slightly moistened cloth. Always wipe over again with a dry cloth.

**Do not use any hard or rough cloths (including microfibre cloths), aggressive or abrasive cleaning agents or solvents.** These can damage the veneered or lacquered surfaces. In the case of stubborn dirt, you are advised to contact the VS Service department directly.
